Adding or Updating a MARC Tag and Subfields can be easily accomplished by using MARC 21 Bibliographic Tags. Simply using a Copy and Paste approach to add information into the MARC Tag Maintenance template fields is the best method.

Use the MARC 21 Bibliographic – Concise Data

Use Copy and Paste

- Some Tags being added are designated as Repeatable, mark the appropriate field.
- When any new Tag has been added, modified or removed, run Re-link Codes

Copy and Paste only the Tag number in this field

Copy and Add each component in both Indicator 1 and Indicator 2 into each field and click the "Add" to complete.
